PIANO CLASS FOR LOCALS

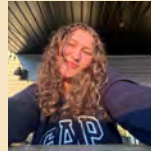

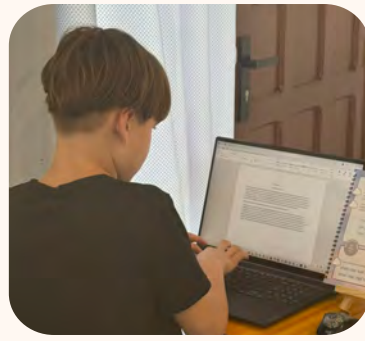


HAPPY BIRTHDAY
