La Comunidad De Fe

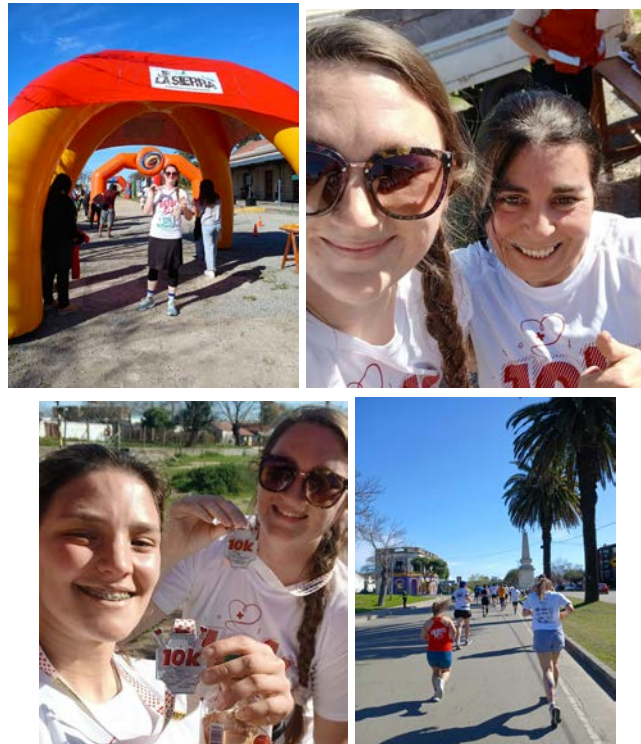
I've continued to attend services here in San Jose de Mayo at LCF. I have been able to continue to sing on Sundays with the worship team, preach various messages and teach bible studies.
