Bro. Gwebu taught Sunday School and Bro. Sheppard Preached on "Where are The Miracles?" Numbers 23:19.

Miracles come through our Faith in God, but as James 2:17 says, Faith by itself isn't enough. It should produce your Good Deeds. You should be living a life that shows your Faith. It shows your Trust and Confidence in God.

She spoke on The Crucifixion of Jesus Christ and told of His Sufferings. There is no other Name under Heaven whereby we must be saved. But we are brought near to God only by the Blood of Jesus Christ, because Life is In the Blood. We have to

keep the Blood that He so willingly shed because He loved us more deeply than we can comprehend.
